LCUUF BOARD POLICY ON CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS

Adopted by the Board of Directors: April 17, 2023

In order to be considered for inclusion in charitable giving by LCUUF, the following conditions must be met:

- Each charity must have been reviewed and recommended by the LCUUF Social Action Team to ensure the charity meets UU Principles and Goals for the fellowship.
- 2. Each charity must be a registered A.C. (Asociación Civil) in good (active) standing.
- 3. If a charity is not an A.C. or registered with the Foundation for Lake Chapala Charities (FLCC), it should be vetted per <u>FLCC</u> <u>guidelines for non-A.C. charities</u>.
- 4. The Board prefers that each charity be registered with the FLCC because it:
 - a. provides good oversight
 - b. provides a variety of online and other modes of donation
 - c. can provide a US tax-deductible receipt to members.
- 5. Each charity must provide at least annual reports to the LCUUF Treasurer regarding how funds have been used.
- 6. Each charity funded by LCUUF will be reviewed on an annual basis by the Social Action Team and the Board of Directors.
- 7. The Board of Directors shall make the final determination of whether or not a charity is funded by LCUUF, either as a line item on the budget (labeled Community Outreach) or via regular or special collections.
